








TRAUMA-INFORMED MANAGEMENT

EVERY KID, EVERY WOMAN, EVERY FAMILY ARE VULNERABLE GROUP AND SHOULD BE TREATED AS VULNERABLE









WHAT KIND OF STEPS CAN HELP?

HOME VISITS BY SOCIAL WORKERS

ADDITIONAL ATTENTION FROM TEACHERS (SCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN) WHO WORK IN CLASSES WITH **REFUGEES ON SCANNING OF ABUSE, EXPLOITATION,** DEEP PSYCHOLOGICAL TRAUMA

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR REFUGEE FAMILIES FROM SCHOOL SIDE (ADAPTATION, PSYCHOLOGICAL CONSULTATIONS)

WHAT ELSE TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT?

Not to confuse war psychological trauma and signs of abuse and exploitation

Less pressure on assimilation. We are really grateful but the majority of families plan to come back home

No stigma from the society that this is window of opportunity for Ukrainians to move to Europe

Try to really listen. Without bias

HOW TO PROTECT?

PROVIDE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON POSSIBLE RISK ON EVERY POINT OF CONTACT WITH REFUGEES (REGISTRATION CENTERS, PHONE CONTACTS, SHELTERS ETC)

SEE REFUGEES AS ONE MORE VULNERABLE GROUP AND TRY TO THINK ABOUT WHAT YOU CAN DO



ESTABLISH CONTACTS AND COLLABORATION WITH UKRAINIAN NGO. THEY HAVE CULTURAL UNDERSTANDING, YOU HAVE ACCESS TO THE REFUGEES.
