In the first instance you should consult you organisation's safeguarding policies and proceedures and discuss with the safeguarding lead.

Key Safeguarding Messages:

Worried about a child?

Significant concerns about immediate harm - call 999.

Call **0300 131 2 131** to discuss a referral.

Everyone has a responsibility to refer a child when it is believed or suspected that a child:

- Has suffered significant harm and /or;
- Is likely to suffer significant harm and/or;
- Has developmental and welfare needs which are likely only to be met through provision of family support services (with agreement of the child's parent).
